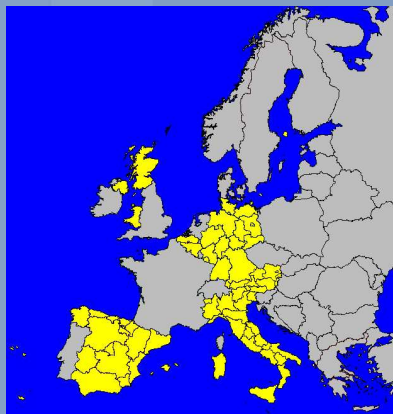

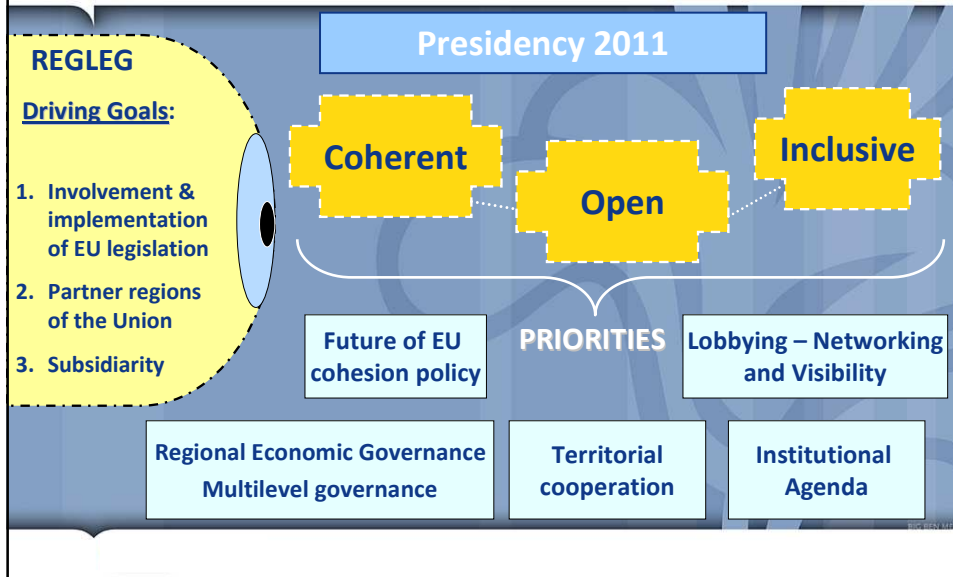

 - European Parliament, European Commission
 - EU Council, Committee of the Regions⇒ Binding agreements
- **EGTC**
 - European conference on the European Grouping for Territorial Cooperation EGTC.
 - Launch of the EGTC platform of the Committee of the Regions
 - Regleg is a member of the Subsidiarity Monitoring Network

- To network and cooperate with other regional and european networks/institutions (CoE, AER,...)
- To continue the cooperation with the **Conference of European regional legislative assemblies (CALRE)** on the basis of a common strategy (bilateral agreement 23rd Feb. 2011)
- To support the work of the **Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe** in the fields of common interest
